# QUICK PRESSED SPRING FLOWERS



## STEP 1

### CUT FLOWERS

Gather up a few Spring flowers. Pansies & Violas are perfect for this project.



## STEP 2

### ARRANGE

Place a paper towel on top of a plate. Arrange flowers and slightly press down to



## STEP 3

### MICROWAVE

- Cover the flowers with a paper towel and top with a plate.
- Start microwave and check flowers every 30 seconds.
- Mine took 2 minutes to dry.



## STEP 4

### FINISHED

You will be able to tell when the flowers are done. They look dried.



## STEP 5

### PROJECT IDEA

I i glued the pressed flowers to a piece of cardstock with a small amount of clear glue and placed in an open frame.



## STEP 6

### TIP

Keep the flowers out of direct sunlight. It will cause them to fade.



*Pressed Spring Flowers*

A wooden frame with a light-colored interior holds a collection of pressed spring flowers and leaves. The specimens include several purple pansies of various patterns, two bright red poppies, a cluster of small white daisies, and a few green leaves, including a large one with three lobes. Some stems and buds are also visible. The frame is set against a dark, textured background.





# HOW TO MAKE *A Bird's Nest*

There's no need to spend money on craft store bird's nests (they are \$\$)!! Here's my secret to making them yourself!

You will need spray adhesive and Spanish moss. Moss & mini eggs to embellish. Wear gloves!!

Grab a clump of Spanish moss, spray the adhesive on it.

Use your fingers to create a circular shape while pressing down in center to create the nest.

Use more spray adhesive to add pieces of greenmoss and mini eggs.



# Spring CENTERPIECE



## *Live Spring Plants*

Buy a few small Spring potted flowers & bulbs.  
I am using primrose, hyacinth, and pansies.



## *Prepare Planter*

Grab a footed pedestal bowl, tureen, or wide planter  
Add small pebbles to the bottom of the bowl for  
drainage.



## *Add Plants*

Arrange the plants and flowering bulbs in the  
bowl.



## *Added Detail*

For an extra touch add a small Spring figurine.



To finish off the Spring centerpiece I added a few pussy willow branches and wrapped a piece of grapevine garland around the bowl





# Easter Wreath

## Supplies:

- Wood Bunny & Egg Shapes (Dollar Tree)
- Oval Wreath Frame
- White, Green, & Brown Paint
- Moss
- Cotton Balls



## STEPS



- PAINT EGGS WITH GREEN CRAFT PAINT
- **PAINT BUNNIES WITH WHITE CRAFT PAINT**
- DAB A PAPER TOWEL IN BROWN PAINT AND RUN AROUND EDGES OF BUNNIES.
- **LET PAINT DRY**





- BRUSH EGGS WITH MOD PODGE
- **COVER W/ MOSS AND TRIM AROUND THE EDGES.**
- USE COTTON TO MAKE BUNNY TAIL
- **HOT GLUE SHAPES TO OVAL WREATH ALTERNATING BETWEEN SHAPES.**

# MOSS BRANCHES

1

## **S U P P L I E S**

You will need a set of artificial twig branches and a bag of mixed moss & lichen.

2

## **B R A N C H E S**

Spread out branches on a flat surface and bend into the shape you want.

3

## **H O T   G L U E**

Concentrate on the larger sections of the branches. Run a bead of hot glue onto branch.

4

## **A D D   M O S S**

Glue small pieces of the moss to branches being careful not to burn yourself on the hot glue.

5

## **D I S P L A Y**

You can display the branches alone in a vase or mix in with other flowers for a fresh Spring look.

The second picture is artificial tulips!!



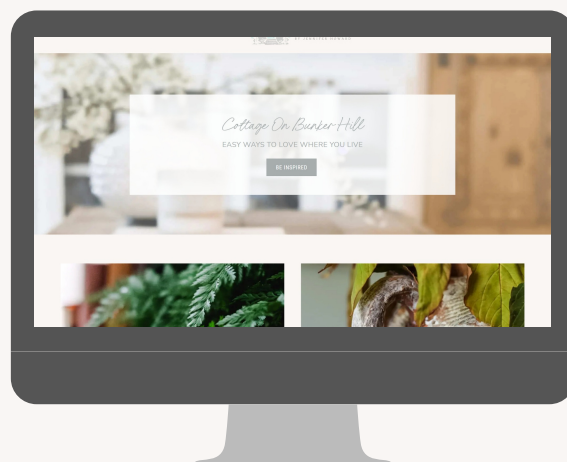
